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### DAY 1 (Nov 30) **Depart USA to Tel Aviv via Toronto, (Schedule subject to change)**

DAY 2 (Dec 1) **Arrival in the Holy Land** in the morning where we are met by a representative to assist us through customs and transfer us to our hotel on the Sea of Galilee. Along the way, we will stop and see **Caesarea / Megiddo (Armageddon)** / and then **Tiberias**. Caesarea is a Crusader Fortress built upon the ancient city of Caesarea Maritima, named after Augustus Caesar, who imposed the tax that brought Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem. Here is a beautiful example of the Roman Amphitheatre built in the days of Christ. We'll continue to Mount Carmel where Elijah issued his challenge to the False Prophets. Then on to Megiddo, site of Armageddon. Dinner and overnight at our hotel the Sofia Sea of Galilee in Tiberias.

DAY 3 (Dec 2) **Mt of Beatitudes / Capernaum / Nazareth Village** : We visit where Jesus gave the Beatitudes, then Capernaum, Jesus' headquarters, where he taught in the synagogue on many occasions, and performed many miracles. Take a drive to Nazareth and see a village similar to the time of Jesus. Dinner and overnight at our hotel Sofia Sea of Galilee.

DAY 4 (Dec 3) **Boat Ride on Sea of Galilee / Jesus Boat Museum / Caesarea Philippi / Tel Dan / Baptism in the Jordan River**: We board a boat for a cruise on the Sea of Galilee. Then visit the Jesus Boat, which is in a museum situated on Kibbutz Nof Ginossar. We head north on the road through the Golan Heights, where we will hear the explanations of the strategic and political significance of this area. On the Golan Heights we visit Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus asks, "Who do men say that I am?" A question everyone must answer. We then visit the Tel Dan, the capital city of Israel where Jeroboam erected a golden calf. Ending a magnificent day with a visit to Yardenit, the traditional baptismal site on the Jordan River. If you desire to be baptized in the Jordan, please talk to your pastor. Return to hotel Sofia Sea of Galilee in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5 (Dec 4) **Beit Shean / Border Crossing to Jordan at the Sheik Hussein Bridge/ Mt. Nebo / Petra**: We proceed through the city of Beit Shean - one of the earliest and most important cities in Israel from the time of the Canaanites. It was here the Philistines impaled King Saul's body to the city wall - we view its magnificent excavations. Then cross into Jordan to Mt. Nebo, the place where Moses was granted a view of the Promised Land. Then

**DAY 6** (Dec 5) Full day to explore **Petra**: The adventure begins via a narrow canyon called Al Siq, that opens up to contain tombs and temples carved into pink sandstone cliffs, earning its nickname, the "Rose City." Put on your hiking shoes, this is a great day of exploration and adventure. Travel to Crowne Plaza **Amman** for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 7** (Dec 6) **Border crossing at Allenby Bridge / Qumran / Wadi Qelt / Jerusalem**: Our next adventure is to cross back into Israel and then to the Dead Sea, lowest spot on earth and visit Qumran, center of the Essenes. Visit the ancient caves of Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Then travel up to Jerusalem via the Wadi Qelt, to our hotel Ramada in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 8** (Dec 7) **Mt. of Olives / Garden of Gethsemane / House of Caiaphas / Temple Institute/ Old City Jerusalem**: This morning we start the day at Mt. of Olives for an introduction to Jerusalem. Ascend the mountains of Jerusalem from Mt. Scopus to Mt. of Olives for an outstanding breathtaking view of the city across the Kidron Valley to the Eastern Gate; see Chapel of Ascension, walk down Palm Sunday Road. Travel to the house of Caiaphas and visit the Upper Room and Tomb of King David. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**DAY 9** (Dec 8) **Davidson Center / Southern Steps / Rabbinical Tunnels / Pool of Bethesda / Praetorium / Fortress of Antonia / Via Dolorosa**  
Start off the day in the City of David at the Davidson Center then up hill to the Southern Steps of the Southern Wall. Visit the famous Rabbi's Tunnel, running along the base of the Western Wall. Then the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus cured an invalid man; continue to the Praetorium, site of the public trial of Christ, and his condemnation, and view its ancient remains in the Fortress of Antonia; Continue through the picturesque market streets walking along the Via Dolorosa. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**DAY 10** (Dec 9) **Masada / Ein Gedi / Dead Sea float / Jerusalem**: Travel east to the mighty fortress Massada, last stronghold and stand of the zealots against Rome, on the edge of the barren Negev Desert then to Ein Gedi, David's hideout from Saul, and then finish off the day to swim (float) in the salty waters of the Dead Sea on the way back to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 11** (Dec 10) **Temple Mount (security permitting) / Friends of Zion (FOZ) / Israeli Museum / Garden Tomb / Farewell Dinner**: Walk along the temple mount see the Dome of the Rock, East Gate and the Dome of the Spirits where the Third Temple will be built. At the FOZ Heritage Center visitors enter a whole new world, where they meet the biblical figures, academics, businessmen, and military officials who, through their faith, have forged an everlasting bond between the Jewish and Christian. Israeli Museum is a fascinating place that holds the ancient Jerusalem Model and Dead Sea Scrolls. End the day with prayer and communion at the Garden Tomb and then our Farewell Dinner. Transfer to hotel and morning departure back to USA.

**DAY 12** (Dec 11) **Travel day and arrive home to everyone's USA city by the afternoon.**
