- Romans 15:14-21
 - Verse 14, Paul is confident in the Romans for what 3 things:
 - Why is the 2nd thing necessary for the Romans to be able to do the 3rd?
 - Verse 15-16, Why was Paul able to write boldly? What was his goal and purpose in this goal?
