19. In verse 16, faith is according to what? Why is this important?

20. God gave a promise to Abraham. What was the promise from these verses and why is Abraham an example of faith? (Make a list of everything that points to Abraham's faith.)

21. What does God do in verse 17 that is significant?

22. What was written according to verse 23 and why was it written?

23. According to Romans 4:24-25, list the three facts in which we must believe for God's promise to be "imputed" to us.

24. What have you learned about faith in this study? Why is there no opportunity for boasting?
