Romans 5: 1-11 – Read for Context

Romans 5:1-2

1. Verse 1 state we have “been justified by faith.” Looking into the “therefore” at the beginning of the verse, what are the other two ways people attempt to be justified in Chapter 4?
2. Through Jesus Christ we have what three things according to verses 1 and 2?
 - What happens as a result of righteousness according to Isaiah 32:17?
 - What does grace do in Titus 2:11-13?

3. In what are we to rejoice or glory in according to verse 3 and why (verse 3-4)
4. The final aspect of the list above does not disappoint for what reason in verse 5 and how is it given to us?
5. How are we described when Jesus Christ died for us in verse 6-8?
6. Who instigated this action by Jesus and why? (Verse 8)
 - Compare Jesus’ actions in Romans 5:6-8 with those He desires in us according to John 15:12-15?

7. In verse 9, how are we justified? From what are we saved?

8. What do you learn about reconciliation from verse 10 and 11?
 - What do you discover about reconciliation in 2 Corinthians 5:18-21?
